

A BILL

To require elementary schools and secondary schools to provide an option for safe, in-person attendance during school years 2020–2021 and 2021–2022.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Educational Flexibility
5 for Families Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. REQUIREMENT FOR SAFE, IN-PERSON ATTENDANCE**
2 **OPTION.**

3 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—Beginning on the date of enact-
4 ment of this Act, no amounts are authorized to be appro-
5 priated for school years 2020–2021 and 2021–2022 to any
6 elementary school or secondary school, or any local edu-
7 cational agency or State educational agency that serves
8 an elementary school or secondary school, that does not
9 provide an option for students to attend classes, safely and
10 in-person, at the school during such school year.

11 (b) **DEFINITIONS.**—The terms “elementary school”,
12 “secondary school”, “local educational agency”, and
13 “State educational agency” have the meanings given the
14 terms in section 8101 of the Elementary and Secondary
15 Education Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 7801).
