A BILL

To require elementary schools and secondary schools to provide an option for safe, in-person attendance during school year 2020–2021.

- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Educational Flexibility
- 5 for Families Act".

1 SEC. 2. REQUIREMENT FOR SAFE, IN-PERSON ATTENDANCE

- 2 **OPTION.**
- 3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Beginning on the date of enact-
- 4 ment of this Act, no amounts are authorized to be appro-
- 5 priated for school year 2020–2021 to any elementary
- 6 school or secondary school, or any local educational agency
- 7 or State educational agency that serves an elementary
- 8 school or secondary school, that does not provide an option
- 9 for students to attend classes, safely and in-person, at the
- 10 school during such school year.
- 11 (b) Definitions.—The terms "elementary school",
- 12 "secondary school", "local educational agency", and
- 13 "State educational agency" have the meanings given the
- 14 terms in section 8101 of the Elementary and Secondary
- 15 Education Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 7801).
